## The Woman who Gave a Little but Gave Everything! (Easy)



1. One day Jesus was teaching a large <u>crowd</u> of people in the <u>Jewish</u> temple in Jerusalem. They <u>gathered around</u> Him and <u>gladly</u> listened to His teaching. As He <u>taught</u> them, He <u>warned</u> them, "<u>watch out</u> <u>for</u> the <u>teachers of the law</u>."

2. He told them that these teachers were not good people. They teach others how they are to live (i.e 'You must do this. You must do that.'), but they did not do themselves, what they taught others to do. Jesus <u>explained</u> that these teachers "like to walk around and have people <u>greet</u> them in the market and have the best seats at <u>banquets</u>."





3. He also taught that these teachers <u>cheated</u> <u>widows</u> and took money from them so that it was very difficult to <u>make a living</u> for themselves.



4. When He <u>finished</u> teaching, Jesus sat down across from the place in the temple, where people brought in their gifts of money. As He watched the people bring their <u>offerings</u>, He saw many rich people come and bring lot of money and drop it into the offering box.

Then He saw a very poor widow come and drop in two small coins - <u>worth</u> about half a Thai baht.

5. Jesus called His twelve disciples to <u>gather around</u> Him and asked them if they had seen <u>what had just happened</u>. He <u>explained</u>, "These rich people have been putting lots of money into the offering box. They have given just a little of what they own. They are very wealthy.

6. "But the truth is," Jesus said, "this poor widow has <u>given more than</u> <u>all the others put together!</u> She is very poor but has <u>given</u> the biggest offering today. She has put <u>in all that she had - everything that she had</u> <u>to live on.</u>

Jesus could see into her heart and knew all about her life's circumstances. He cared about her and her needs. The Bible does not tell us, but He probably reached out to help her that day!
