Wise Men Bring their Gifts

- 1. At the time of Jesus' birth, a special star appeared in the sky.

 News about this <u>reached</u> Jerusalem <u>several months later</u>, when a group of <u>scholars showed up</u> in the palace of King Herod. They came asking, "Where is He that is born, King of the Jews?" They explained, that they were from a <u>distant land</u> to the East and that had seen an <u>extraordinary</u> star in the sky <u>several months earlier</u>. They had traveled a <u>great distance</u> because they wanted to worship this <u>extraordinary</u> Person.
- 2. Their <u>inquiry</u> about the birth of this "King of the Jews" <u>created quite a stir</u> in the palace. King Herod was a <u>Gentile</u> King and ruled over the Jews who lived in his kingdom. "Who was this Person whom these "wise men" were <u>seeking?</u>

 Could it be that there was Someone who would be his <u>rival</u> and a <u>threat</u> to His kingdom?" These questions filled his heart.
- 3. King Herod was <u>disturbed</u> and all the people of Jerusalem were quite <u>apprehensive</u> with him. The king <u>hastily</u> called together his <u>wisest</u> men chief priests and teachers of the law and asked them where the king whose coming was promised in the <u>Scriptures</u>, was to be born. They replied that the place mentioned in the Scriptures was the small town of Bethlehem.
- 3. King Herod <u>ordered</u> everyone out of the room and called the group of "wise men" in for a <u>personal audience</u> with him. After asking about the <u>exact time</u> that the extraordinary star <u>appeared</u>, he sent them on their journey to Bethlehem. He ordered them to, "go <u>search</u> <u>diligently</u> for the child. As soon as you have found Him, report to me, so I too may go and <u>worship Him</u>."
- 5. The wise men left the King's <u>presence</u> and as they <u>traveled</u> away from Jerusalem, the special star was again <u>visible</u>. They were <u>overjoyed</u> and <u>eager</u> as they <u>drew closer</u> to the place where they would find the child they had traveled so far to see. As they reached Bethlehem, the star stood over the house where Jesus and His parents were living.
- 6. They saw the young child with His mother and <u>bowed down</u> and <u>worshipped</u> Him. They opened up their <u>treasures</u> and <u>presented</u> their gifts to Him gold, <u>incense</u> and <u>myrrh</u>.
- 7. But Herod had no intention of worshipping the child they had told him about. He intended to do away with him. Strangely enough, he did not send any of his associates with the wise men but trusted them to come back and report to him. But God planned to protect Jesus from Herod's scheme. He warned them, in a dream, that they should return home by another route and not go to Jerusalem!
- 8. Then God warned Joseph, in a dream, that the child's life was in danger. Joseph was instructed to take his wife, Mary and the young child Jesus, and <u>escape</u> to Egypt. Herod <u>realized</u> that he had been <u>tricked</u> by the wise men. He killed all baby boys, two years old and younger, in the area around Bethlehem. This young family lived in Egypt, until they heard that Herod had died and no one now sought to take the young child's life.
