## The Storm and Fearful Hearts that Became Peaceful

- 1. As we read the newspaper and watch the news on TV these days, we <u>realize</u> that there are many <u>scary</u> things happening all around the world. Many people have had experiences that have changed their lives forever. Each of us hope that we will be able to live in peace without having to experience what we are watching on our TV's.
- 2. We have all had <u>frightening</u> experiences in our lives. We have each felt <u>overwhelmed</u> and did not know what to do? We have felt that we needed someone to help us someone who understands us, and our <u>circumstances</u>. Each of us has different fears, so we can <u>probably relate to</u> the following story from the Bible, about a <u>frightening</u> storm.
- 3. This story took place on the "Sea of Galilee", a lake in Palestine. Several of Jesus' disciples were <u>fishermen</u> so they had been in many storms on that lake before. But this storm was so severe that even they were <u>very</u> frightened!
- 4. One evening, Jesus said to His disciples, "Let's go across the lake to the other side." So they got into the boat and started out. "On the way across, Jesus lay down for <u>a nap</u>, and while He was sleeping the wind began to rise."  $NLB^*$



- 5. When the boat was in the middle of the lake, the wind began to blow very strongly and the waves began to beat against their small boat. It looked like their boat might sink. Their lives were in real danger. The boat was nearly filled with water.
- 6. Everyone in the boat was very frightened. That is, everyone but Jesus. He 'was sleeping at the back of the boat with His head on a cushion. <u>Frantically</u> they woke Him up, shouting, 'Teacher, don't you even care that we are going to drown?' "NLB\*



- 7. When Jesus woke up, He spoke to the wind and the water with its strong waves. "Quiet down!" He said. <u>Immediately</u> the wind stopped blowing and the waves stopped and there was a great calm.
- 8. Then Jesus asked the people in the boat, "'Why are you so afraid? Do you still not have faith in me?' And they were filled with awe and said among themselves, 'Who is this man, that even the wind and the waves obey Him?' "NLB\*
