## Christmas: The Birthday Celebrated around the World!

- 1. One day, over 2000 years ago, an angel visited a young Jewish woman named Mary. He told her that she was going to have a baby. She was told to give Him the name, Jesus. Mary was <u>troubled</u> by the news. She asked the angel how this could happen because she was only <u>engaged</u> to Joseph and was still a <u>virgin</u>. The angel <u>explained</u> that Joseph was not the baby's father but that she would have this baby by the <u>power of God's Holy Spirit</u>. Mary told the angel that she was willing to serve God by being the mother of this special baby.

- 3. During this period of time, the Jewish people were under Roman rule. Caesar Augustus ordered that a <u>census</u> be taken to learn about the people who were under his control. He <u>ordered</u> the people to return to their <u>birthplace</u> to <u>register</u>. Joseph was from a small town called Bethlehem and so he took

Mary with him to register there.

 Weary from their journey, Mary and Joseph arrived in Bethlehem to find that

every hotel was full and there was no place for them to stay. Mary was about

to <u>deliver her baby</u> and one hotel owner (innkeeper) had <u>compassion</u> on them and <u>offered</u> them a place to lie down. It was in the cattle stall where the animals were kept. They <u>accepted</u> his offer.



5. That night, Mary gave birth to a baby boy. She <u>wrapped</u> him up in long strips of cloth and laid him on the <u>straw</u>. Mary and Joseph named their boy, Jesus, just as the angel had <u>instructed</u> them. People in every country of the world celebrate His birthday.
