A Special Place Prepared for Special People

The world is just a very small part of an *immense* universe, governed by *unchanging laws of nature*. The earth is located the *exact distance* from the sun which keeps it from freezing or burning up. The earth *revolves* at a *consistent speed*. Days and nights follow each other faithfully.

The Bible says, "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth." But something happened and darkness and water covered all the earth. There was no life, no trees, flowers, animals or humans. But God changed all that by His mighty power.
