
- 1. Have you ever been hurt by someone? They may have hurt you by what they said or by the things they did to you. Maybe you have not been able to <u>forget</u> what they have done to hurt you. This story is about help for people who are <u>hurting</u> and need help.
- 2. Zacchaeus lived nearly 2000 years ago, but his story is still being told around the world. He was always <u>hurting</u> people. He was a Jew, who lived in a small <u>Jewish</u> town. His job was to make his Jewish neighbors pay <u>tax</u> money to the <u>Roman government</u>. He was always <u>cheating</u> people by making them pay more <u>taxes</u> than they needed to pay. He gave part of the money to the government and part of it, he put into his own <u>pocket</u>. In this way, he became very rich. But he did not have any friends <u>nor</u> any peace in his heart.
- 3. One day a large group of people came together in his town. Some of them had <u>traveled</u> from other towns. They were <u>following</u> a man named, Jesus. They wanted to listen to His <u>teachings</u> and to see what miracle He would do next.



- 4. Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus that day too, but he had two problems. There were so many people that he could not get near to where Jesus was and he was a very short man. It seemed <u>impossible</u> for him to be able to see Jesus.
- 5. So he <u>decided</u> to <u>climb</u> up in a tree, beside the road. Jesus would come walking into the town along that road. Zacchaeus knew he would see Jesus when He walked by. But when the <u>crowd</u> came to the tree where he was sitting, Jesus <u>stopped</u>. He looked up into the tree, and called out, "Zacchaeus, <u>hurry down</u>. I am going to *your* house today!"



- 7. The people who knew Zacchaeus saw <u>what had happened</u> and began talking to each other. "Jesus is going to *that <u>sinner's</u>* house," they said. They were not happy because they <u>hated</u> Zacchaeus and were <u>surprised</u> that Jesus wanted to go to *his* house.
- 8. As Jesus and Zacchaeus talked, Zacchaeus told Jesus that he would give half of the things he <u>owned</u> to the poor. He added, "I will pay back the money I have taken from my neighbors, for I have <u>cheated</u> them by taking too much tax money." When Jesus heard that, He said to him, "A <u>change of heart</u> has taken place in this house today." Everyone in that small town saw that Zacchaeus had <u>changed</u> and had <u>stopped cheating</u> and <u>hurting</u> people.
