

Where Did Human Life Come From?

- 1. God made the world in order to have a place for humans to live! But when He made humans, He did not just speak and command a human being to <u>come into existence</u>. But He took some soil from the ground and with special care <u>formed</u> a man's body out of it. The man was lying before Him on the ground <u>lifeless</u>. Then God gave him life, when
 - He <u>breathed</u> His own life into the man's <u>nostrils</u>. He stood up the first living, human being!
- 2. God named the man Adam and planted a beautiful garden for him to live in. He told Adam to take care of the garden. God did not want Adam to be alone, so He made lots of animals to live there with him. God made many different species and gave Adam the responsibility of giving a name to each kind of animal.

The animals were not able to <u>communicate</u> with him on his own level. Then God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone. I will make a <u>suitable companion</u> for him."



- 5. When Adam woke up, God brought the woman to him and <u>presented</u> her to him, as his wife! Her name was Eve. They began to enjoy life together in the garden the place that God had prepared for them to live. Each evening, God came and walked and talked with them in the <u>coolness</u> and beauty of the garden. Everything was perfect! They had no <u>arguments</u>. They lived in peace together.
- 6. This is what the Bible teaches about how God created the first couple and brought them together as husband and wife. Marriage and family was God's idea. He <u>instructed</u> that a man should leave his father and mother and be <u>united</u> to his wife and be <u>faithful</u> to each other. He <u>instructed</u> them to have a family and begin to fill the earth with human beings.
- 7. When God instructed the first <u>couple</u> to have children, He was telling them how to pass on His life and to <u>expand</u> the human race throughout the whole earth. In this way, life from God is still being <u>passed on</u> from parents to children. The life in you and in the baby that was born five minutes ago is from God! Each person in the world is a special and <u>unique</u> <u>creation of God!</u>
