the cornerstone of growing the Body of Christ in a nation - without prayer it will not happen.

This is the first of many emails we will send you highlighting different areas and provinces in Thailand. Our desire is that you would use these emails to pray specifically for this nation and to share this email with your church, your small group, your social media network and among your Christian friends so they too can pray.

The map in this email is called "The Light of Christ in Thailand." The yellow areas are places where churches are located. If there are many churches in an area the yellow is brighter or turns red. If there are no churches the area is dark blue. As you can see in this map, the northern part of Thailand has 50% of the churches. Even though there are more churches in the north, that does not mean more are not needed – it just shows where the majority of the churches are located. As you move south and east there are vast areas where there are no churches. The data elements on the left side of the map provide national statistics about the Church in Thailand. Subsequent emails will provide maps and data on a provincial level.

As you pray for Thailand here are specific items to pray for.

- 1. Pray for the health of the king of Thailand.
- 2. Pray for the new Thai government.
- 3. Pray for the thousands of people affected by flooding all over Thailand
- 4. Pray that God would send workers into the dark areas where there are no churches.
- 5. Praise the Lord that nationally, church membership is growing at a rate of 4 to 5% a year. Seven times faster than the biological birth rate.
- 6. Pray for Vision 2015 that God would raise up 100,000 Thai church members to become disciple makers to reach their friends and neighbors for Christ so in the year 2015 we will have 1,000,000 followers of Jesus in Thailand
- 7. Pray for those God raises up to be disciple-makers, that they would be courageous in sharing their faith and faithful in discipling new believers.
