The Government Official who Believed Without Seeing! John 4:43-53

1. The government <u>official</u> living in Capernaum had a young son that he <u>dearly loved</u>. But one day, the young boy became very sick. His father became very <u>concerned</u> about him. He was afraid that he was going to lose his special little boy. The doctors could not do anything to help. It looked like the young boy was going to die.



- 2. The little boy's father had heard about Jesus who had healed many sick people in the land of Israel where he lived. He <u>believed</u> in his heart that Jesus could help his son. Then he heard that Jesus was coming into his area of Galilee. The boy's father began to think of taking his son to Jesus. But he <u>realized</u> that his son was too sick to travel anywhere.
- 3. So the <u>concerned</u> father <u>decided</u> that he needed to go and bring Jesus back to his home. He wanted Jesus to come and heal his son. Then someone told him the good news that Jesus was coming to the town of Cana, 15 kilometers away. So he

traveled to Cana to look for Jesus.

- 4. When he found Jesus, he <u>begged</u> Him to come <u>at once</u> to his home in Capernaum and heal his son who was about to die. When Jesus heard the <u>worried</u> father's <u>request</u>, He asked him a question: "Do you think you can <u>believe</u> **before** seeing me do something <u>amazing</u> for your son?"
- 5. He did not answer Jesus' question, but instead he "pleaded, 'Lord, please come now before my little boy dies.' Then Jesus told him, 'Go back home. Your son will live!' And the man believed Jesus' words." NLB* Then with faith in his heart, he turned around and started his journey back to his home. He went alone, without taking Jesus with him!





6. "While he was on his way, some of his servants met him with the news that his son was alive and <u>well</u>. He asked them when the boy had begun to feel better and they <u>replied</u>, 'Yesterday afternoon at one o'clock his fever <u>suddenly</u> <u>disappeared!</u>'

Then the father <u>realized</u> it was the <u>exact same time</u> that Jesus had told him, 'Your son will live.' And the officer and his entire household believed in Jesus." NLB^*
