

Campbell, Howard (1866-1957)

Campbell was a Presbyterian missionary in northern Siam. He was born in Moniteau, Pennsylvania, 12 October 1866 and graduated from Grove City College in 1891. He graduated from Western Theological Seminary in 1894. In June 1894, he married Sarah Elizabeth Carlon (1864-1920). The Campbells arrived in Bangkok in November 1894 and spent their entire missionary career in Chiang Mai. Campbell served as pastor of First Church, Chiang Mai, for most of that career. Sarah died in February 1920, and in May 1920, Campbell married Mary Carnahan Shellman (née Guy) (1883-1962), the widow of Dr. Carl Shellman. Campbell died 14 October 1957.
