## The Man Born Blind who was Able to See Jesus Jesus said: I am the Light of the World.

- 1. One day Jesus and His disciple s were walking together and met a man who had been blind since birth. The disciples asked Jesus, Teacher, was this man born blind because of his own sin or the sin of his parents? Jesus answered that the man s <u>blindness</u> was *not* because of anyone s sins his own or his parents. Jesus explained that this man was blind so that <u>God s power may</u> be seen at work in him. God <u>planned</u> to do something special for th is man and so <u>allowed</u> him to be born blind.
- 2. Jesus knew that God had sen t Him into the world. He was given w ork to do for God among the people in <u>Palestine</u> where He lived for thirty-three years. This blind man needed to be healed and receive his sight from God. This was God s will for his life.
- 3. So Jesus went over to the b lind man. He <u>spat</u> on the <u>dusty</u> ground and made some mud. Then he spread the m ud over the blind man s eyes. Go wash in the Pool of Siloam Jesus <u>instructed</u>. The man obeyed and went to the Pool and washed his face. He came back to Jesus and was able to see for the first time in his life!



4. <u>Immediately</u> his neighbors began to talk ab out him. They were amazed at the change



in his life. He had c hanged so much that the people around him were not sure if he was the same person. They kept asking each other, Isn t this the blind beggar who used to sit and beg? Some of his neighbors <u>agreed</u> that he was that man. Others said, No it s not him but someone who looks like the man who used to sit and beg. But the man who had been heale d told them, I am the man!

5. Then the neighbors asked him how he had been healed. He <u>explained</u> that a man named Jesus had made some mud, rubbed it on his eyes and told him to go wash in the Pool of Siloam. So I went and washed a nd now I can see, he <u>exclaimed!</u>



6. After that, some of the <u>Jewish religious leaders</u> kept asking him about Jesus. They were upset that Jesus had healed the man on a <u>religious day of rest</u> on which no one was <u>allowed</u> to do any work. Later that day, Jesus found the man He had healed and asked him, Do you believe in the Son of M an? He answered, Tell me who He is, and I will believe in Him. Jesus answered, You have already seen Him and He is the person who is talking with you now. I believe, the man said.

7. Many people did not understand who Jesus was. But a few days before he healed the blind man, He had explained, I am the Light of the World. No one who follows Me will walk in darkness but will have the light of life. The world is filled with darkness just like the man s life was dark with blindness. The religious leaders, who ask ed the healed man about Jesus, did not understand and believe that Jesus was from Go d. They were blind, not physically, but spiritually.

- G. Besides the neighbors, who else asked the blind man to explain how he was healed? Did this group of people have faith in Jesus? Why were they upset with Jesus?
